Hence, please remove all identifying features from the paper itself, ensuring that Authors' identities are not revealed. The Authors are also expected to cite their own works in a manner that does not make their identity explicit:

Acceptable: "Robinson [12] proved that . . ."

Acceptable: "Some authors (e.g., Robinson [12]; Zeidler [14]) indicated that . . ."

Unacceptable: "As we proved [12], . . ."

Unacceptable: "In a previous paper [12], we indicated that . . ."
